Earth Flight Sculpture

- Staff would like to work on securing a plaque over the winter with a goal of spring installation.

Writing Contest

- The winners were recognized at the January 8th Village Board meeting. The commission would like to continue the Writing Contest.

Photo Contest

- The commission came up with a list of theme ideas for the 2024 photo contest. J. Marvin will send out a survey within the next few days with all the proposed themes for the commission to select from.

Stars on Parade

- At a previous meeting, the commission discussed the increased wear and tear on the stars. The commission agreed to repair minor cracks but not to invest into stars further with new topcoats.
- We Are All Made of Stardust Star:
 - This star has been dropped off at the Village Hall and is awaiting repair by J. Marvin and C. Woodard.
- Old #1 Star:
 - Staff were informed by the artist the star was completed, but when Public Works tried to pick it up, it wasn't finished. C. Woodard will paint a topcoat over the repaired area. The star will be reinstalled at a new location in front of the "Old Village Hall" property.
- Mundelein High School Star:
 - The star has been dropped off at the high school and under the care of the MHS art faculty.
- GLORY Star:
 - The star has a significant crack, and some bubbles forming in the topcoat.
- Potential Future Star:
 - C. Woodard expressed interest in behalf of the beautification committee to collaborate on a star with the MAC and Flowerama (possibly Monarch and Marigold theme).

Lure of the Local

- The subcommittee will work on a milestone calendar to establish a work plan throughout the year.
- The MAC discussed a general social media problem – it takes a lot of time and energy to do social media well. Staff has time to *execute* a media plan, but not as much time to create and manage media plans for so many independent projects.
- Planning will start earlier this year. The sub-committee is open to a third member for more assistance if anyone is interested.
- S. Esson suggested that artists be notified earlier this year.
- Rose Ray was very good with managing the music for Lure of the Local.
- Positive Space Studios could take on more ownership over hanging artwork.
- Since the event has become so large, it could be managed more like the Mundelein Grand Prix with regular large-group meetings with all stakeholders.
- Goal – set a date for the show by March 1st.
- Some discussion about whether Lure of the Local should have its own webpage.

Christmas Carol Radio Play

- J. Matousek met with J. Marvin and C. Malec to go over lessons learned and goals for next year.
- A need for a new venue has been identified – the event has outgrown the Village Hall Board Room. Frank Mahar has suggested the Chapel, or Carmel High School is also possible. Diane O'Kelly can provide more practice space but it is not a stage.
- Interest in using Eventbrite next year (for a small cost) to streamline registration and generate confirmation emails.

- Charging \$5 per ticket may reduce the number of no-shows, especially large group no-shows.
- S. Esson volunteered to help with the Christmas Carol project next year.
- Regarding Summer Shakespeare Shorts – J. Matousek wants to target youth this year. Shakespeare shorts by shorties? Joyce Lee would like to be involved.

Skate Park Mural

- Next year, the commission is requesting to reinvent the photo contest flyer.

Stars on Parade

- At a previous meeting, the commission discussed the increased wear and tear on the stars. The commission agreed to repair minor cracks but not invest further in stars with new topcoats.
- We Are All Made of Stardust Star:
 - This star has been dropped off at the Village Hall and is awaiting repair by J. Marvin and C. Woodard.
- Old #1 Star:
 - The artist informed staff that the star was completed, but when Public Works tried to pick it up, it wasn't finished. C. Woodard will paint a topcoat over the repaired area. The star will be reinstalled at a new location in front of the "Old Village Hall" property. There have been no updates from the committee or artist since November 7th, 2023.
- Mundelein High School Star:
 - The star has been dropped off at the high school and is under the care of the MHS art faculty. There have been no updates since September 26th, 2023.
- GLORY Star:
 - The star has a significant crack, bubbles forming in the topcoat, and a chunk of the decorative braiding around the edge has fallen off. Due to the weather, C. Woodard cannot perform any maintenance on this star.
- Potential Future Star:
 - C. Woodard expressed interest on behalf of the beautification committee in collaborating on a star with the MAC and Flowerama (possibly a Monarch and Marigold theme).

The Lure of the Local

- The subcommittee updated the commission on the possibility of extending this event. They would like to open the second weekend of September and stay open till mid-November.
- The subcommittee is open to a third member for more assistance if anyone is interested.
- The subcommittee will meet before the March 18th MAC meeting to start planning this event.

Background:

- NEW UPDATE: We Are All Made of Stardust received its new topcoat, and was installed in its original location near Azteca by Public Works this week. Thank you C. Woodard for transporting!
- We were advised by the artist that the Old #1 star was finished and awaiting pickup, but when Public Works contacted them to arrange for pickup, they said it wasn't finished. We are awaiting word from the sponsor or artist. It will be stored at the Public Works facility temporarily while it has its topcoat brushed on. It will be reinstalled at the "Old Village Hall" property. No updates have been received yet from the artist since November 7th.
- MHS Senior Class Star has been fabricated and dropped off at the high school. It is now under the care of the MHS art faculty (Jonathan Pruc). No updates have been received since September 26th.
- The ☆GLORY☆ star at Chicago/Hawley has a significant crack. C. Woodard put a temporary seal with super glue, as the weather would not permit epoxy to cure. She also noted that there is a strange reaction happening with the paint – paint is bubbling up and it looks like it could crack and come off. Also, a chunk of the decorative braiding around the edge has fallen off. It is acknowledged that this condition is unusual, especially for the star's age, and may be related to the materials used or method of application.

- The Beautification Committee is interested in collaborating on a star with the MAC and Flowerama.
- NEW: The MAC should discuss if there is a desire to order additional stars with the remaining MAC budget.

As a follow-up to the annual update presentation, the Village Board was sent a memorandum with more detail about the “hand” sculpture and a request for feedback. The memo, as well as feedback received thus far, will be forwarded separately to the MAC by email.

Staff requested feedback to three questions:

1. Is the Village Board comfortable with the general concept as a whole? Feedback is welcome about the installation of sculptures in general or the design of this specific sculpture.
2. Is the Village Board comfortable with the proposed location at Courtland Commons?
3. Is the Village Board comfortable with the MAC proceeding quickly on this commissioned sculpture by placing a down payment before May 1, 2024? Or is it preferred that it is deferred to FY2025 (or a later point)?

Background:

The below note is from C. Woodard:

- At our last MAC meeting, Colleen B. reintroduced the idea of a fundraiser for the arts. A mere five days later, Zach Gelfand from Tonality, emailed Colleen M. and me to start the conversation about partnering with the MAC for some events. I contacted Zach and we started brainstorming to lay the groundwork and produce a rough draft for a MAC discussion on a collaboration. All of this is fluid and subject to change; Zach will attend our March MAC meeting to discuss.
- The idea is a showcase for Mundelein musical talent, benefitting the Kracklauer Fund for Public Art and celebrating Tonality's six month anniversary.
- This would be a ticketed event. 110 tickets will be sold at \$35 per ticket, with all proceeds going to the Kracklauer Fund. For their contribution, our patrons of the arts will enjoy appetizers crafted by the chef at Tonality, have a chance to win Tonality gift cards and be entertained by six local musicians. There will be a cash bar.
- Zach proposed a raffle, featuring art donated by local artists. Suz Goedke and The Sarah Factor (Sarah Christ) will run the raffle with all money raised matched by Suz's company, Becton Dickinson. We will have a donation jar with all money raised also matched.

- The date proposed is Thursday, May 16, 6-9 PM. Six local musicians will each play 30-minute sets. Zach proposed to extend the art raffle through the weekend; his staff will take care of the raffle for the weekend.
- Zach and his staff will take care of the logistics at the brewery. They will set up the space for the patrons, the musicians, and the art raffle. The MAC will publicize the event and sell the tickets.
- If interested, we would ask if the musical “wing” of the MAC could assist Zach with identifying six local musicians who will donate their time to benefit the cause.
- We didn't discuss how we would procure art for the raffle; Zach may have some ideas on this. Perhaps we could send out a request to the list of artists we collected at the Lure and/or the MAC could send out a call for artists. We'll figure it out.
- I'd also like to work with the Historical Commission to see if they have some information and pictures of the Kracklauer and the old fire station. A member of the commission could also make a brief statement about the Kracklauer and the fund.
