Miss Mundelein will not be available to attend the pageant this year. The Commission agreed to keep the date of the pageant the same and suggested having her a record a video message to play during the pageant. Liaison Langelier will pay the fees for the Lake County Pageant.

Music

Commissioner Quaiyoom said all bands are booked.

Munch / Food Vendors

Beer Booth

Liaison Langelier explained that Tonality reached out about selling their beer at the

event. There are logistical issues given Kloss is not their distributor. The Commission discussed the use of jockey box and potential setup concerns. Liaison Langelier will reach out to Tonality to discuss more in detail.

The Commission reviewed the schedule of events and discussed potentially eliminating the horseshoe tournament due to low turnout. The Commission discussed other possible events.
